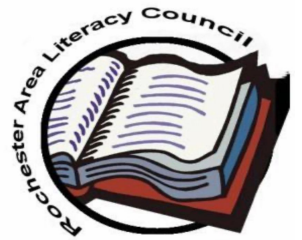

In this interactive session, Dr. Lammers will draw on more than a decade of research about fanfiction writing and online communities to guide participants to make connections between fan-based literacies and classroom-valued practice. Her presentation will highlight not only the experiences of youth fanfiction authors but also of K-12 teachers who have tried implementing fandom-inspired practices in their ELA instruction.



Jayne C. Lammers, Ph.D., is a former middle and high school ELA/Reading teacher. Currently an Associate Professor at the University of Rochester's Warner School of Education and Human Development, Dr. Lammers directs the secondary English teacher preparation program and always seeks to make connections between her research in online spaces and the literacy learning that teachers and students do in their classrooms.
