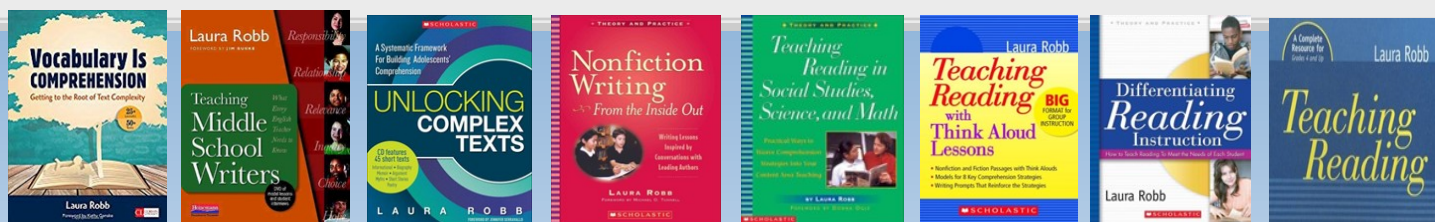

She is a sought-after speaker, beloved by teachers for her commitment to children and adolescents & her ability to show what best practices look like in day-to-day teaching. In addition to her speaking & consulting, she teaches part time in K–8. Recently, the Nassau Reading Council presented Robb with its 2009 Friend of Literacy Award.
