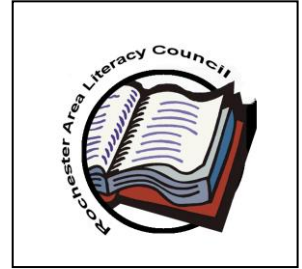

Maureen McLaughlin is a Professor of Reading Education at East Stroudsburg University of Pennsylvania and a past President of ILA, 2013-14. Prior to earning her doctorate at Boston University, Maureen was a classroom teacher, reading specialist, and department chair in a public school system.

Dr. McLaughlin has authored numerous publications including the *Common Core: Teaching K-5 or 6-12 to Meet the Reading Standards*; *Critical Literacy: Enhancing Students' Comprehension of Text*; and *Guided Comprehension in the Primary Grade*. She has served on editorial review boards and has been committee chair for the National Reading Conference and the International Literacy Association.
