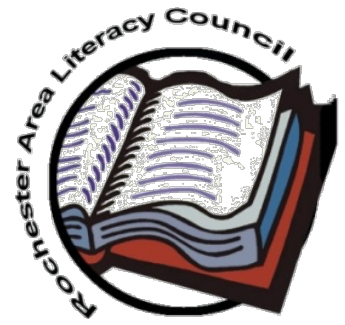

# Ninety Feet Under:

**What poverty does to our students and how you can help them through it.**

Current research shows how poverty devastates the children and parents caught inside it. We'll take a look at the impacts of poverty on the brain, language, literacy, the different realities we live in, and how and why secure early attachment is so critical.

John Strazzabosco, an educator, lecturer and writer, has presented poverty workshops for teachers in the Pittsford Central Schools, RALC, the Downtown Community Forum, Catholic Charities, and other venues. This will mark his 44<sup>th</sup> presentation. John has also written essays and features for the D&C and several books for students. A retired math teacher, John taught for thirty-three years in Pittsford Central Schools.
